



Point Systems for 2018

As we have discussed in prior news releases, the WSBBA continually reviews every aspect of our event system with the goal of providing the very best events for our members and their bull athletes. A number of you have asked the organization to review our Point Systems for Bull of the Year, and Stock Contractor of the Year. After an organizational review over the last three months which included feedback from our members, a decision has been made to keep the point systems the same for the 2018 season. For clarification, these rules are listed below.

Bull of the Year – Futurity, Derby, and Classic bulls are eligible for the award. Points from each event, including the W.S.B.B.A. Finals, will be counted towards a bull's aggregate score at the end of the year. The bull with the most points, in each division, will be awarded the championship.

Contractor of the Year – Points from each event, including the W.S.B.B.A. Finals, will be counted towards a Contractor's aggregate score at the end of the year. However, a contractor will only be able to count their top three bull scores at each individual event. As an example, if the W.S.B.B.A. Tour consisted of four (4) event and the finals, and a contractor attended each event, the maximum number of scores the contractor could count toward their aggregate final score would be fifteen (15).

Incredi-Bull Shootout/W.S.B.B.A. High Bull Champion – Futurity, Derby, Classic and Maturity Bulls are eligible for the award. A bull must attend at least two W.S.B.B.A. sanctioned events along with the W.S.B.B.A. Finals to qualify for the championship. If a bull competes in more than two in events only their top two scores, along with their Final's score, will count towards their aggregate final score.
